

TO BE CONSIDERED FOR REGISTRATION

- CTC strongly recommends taking the **Test for Adult Basic Education (TABE)** prior to the beginning of the course to access Reading and Language skills.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS must be met PRIOR to the first day of class.

- **Payment** of registration and pre-admission fees.
- Completion of all necessary **paperwork** included in the registration packet.
- Valid state **driver's license** or state identification card.
- **PPD or Chest X-ray** to verify absence of Tuberculosis. PPD must not be older than 6 months. If chest x-ray was done, it must be no older than 1 year. (*You may obtain this from your primary care physician, walk-in clinic, or health department*).
- **Urine drug test** no earlier than 2 weeks prior to first day of class.
- **Level II FDLE background check** no earlier than 2 weeks prior to first day of class. Students with an arrest record may be ineligible for training. It is recommended that you verify eligibility by disclosing your situation to the Health Science Program Coordinator prior to enrollment.
- It is recommended that the Hepatitis B vaccine be acquired.

BY THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS you must have:

- Printed results from the PPD or Chest X-ray, urine drug test, Level II FDLE background check
- CTC green shirt
- Book
- Supplies
- You must **bring the CTC Bookstore's tuition receipt for the Nursing Assisting program. You will not be allowed into the class without this receipt.**

STUDENT DRESS CODE FOR CLASS/CLINICALS

- **Class:** CTC green shirts are required with skirts or pants (at least knee length), closed toe shoes (no flip-flops, sandals or slings).
- **Clinicals:** All-white uniform with green smock and white oxfords (white sneakers are acceptable only if they are leather or vinyl).
